Maddli is named after Madeleine Boll, Switzerland's first licensed female footballer. Maddli is a spirited St. Bernard with a big heart and even bigger dreams! A true Swiss icon, St. Bernards are known for their gentle nature and are famous for their role as courageous search dogs in alpine rescue missions.

Red Goals

10 big goals, glowing red, are spread across Zurich, shining a spotlight on the tournament. In the evenings the Red Goals illuminate famous locations around the city. Inspired by a light installation by Hamburg-based artist Michael Batz for the 2006 Men's World Cup.
